# GET TO KNOW THE PROJECT

Sustainable Development Goals for pupils is an Erasmus+ KA2, Cooperation Partnership in School Education project bringing together six (6) partners from five countries. This diversity is important, enabling the project outcomes and results to reach a wide range of target groups.

The overall project objective is to contribute to Education for Sustainable Development (ESD), a key element of the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development. The project aims to design and develop learning materials regarding SDGs that will be used through the online platform that helps pupils between 10-14 years old to develop key competencies such as critical thinking, creativity, and problem-solving. More precisely, the following project objectives will be reached through the activities implementation:



To teach pupils key competencies, critical thinking, creativity, and problem-solving, and empower them towards more sustainable practices;



To provide online interactive SDGs related learning materials and resources built from the ground up.



To improve teachers' digital skills for distance learning and support schools' ability to provide remote education.

The learning materials will be used with gamification methodologies in order to efficiently and effectively engage the pupils in the learning and to provide teachers with engaging and responsive learning materials on digital skills that they can use online with their pupils. The learning materials will be designed to promote the pupils to use critical thinking, creativity and problem solving in order to develop frameworks on how to discuss sustainable development issues.

The teachers will expand their overall digital skills, they will be provided with new digital tools, so that they can more effectively deliver on distance learning and teach about sustainable development goals.

The project results will be disseminated to the following target groups:

Pupils and students, either still in school or outside of the formal educational system or the labour market interested in sustainable development and reaching SDGs;

- Schools, other educational institutions, and CSOs;
- General public, decision-makers: to get to know/understand/become aware of the importance of education in the field of SDGs and the needs of target groups.

## WHAT HAVE WE DONE SO FAR?

The partners from the six organisations met in Skopje on 21st and 22nd March 2023 for the kick off meeting of the project. During the meeting, partners also presented the dissemination plan, quality and risks management plan as well as the roles for each partner for each work package.

The project results that are going to be developed under this project are:

- **Project Result 2:** Developing a teacher training course on digital skills related to distance learning delivered to teachers within the project's scope and made available online.

On the meeting the partners divided between themselves which Sustainable Development Goal they will develop materials in the form of questions, quizzes, challenges and interactive presentations.
