Each project partner was responsible for preparing a detailed plan for two or three SDGs, outlining creative, age-appropriate ways to engage pupils aged 10 to 14.

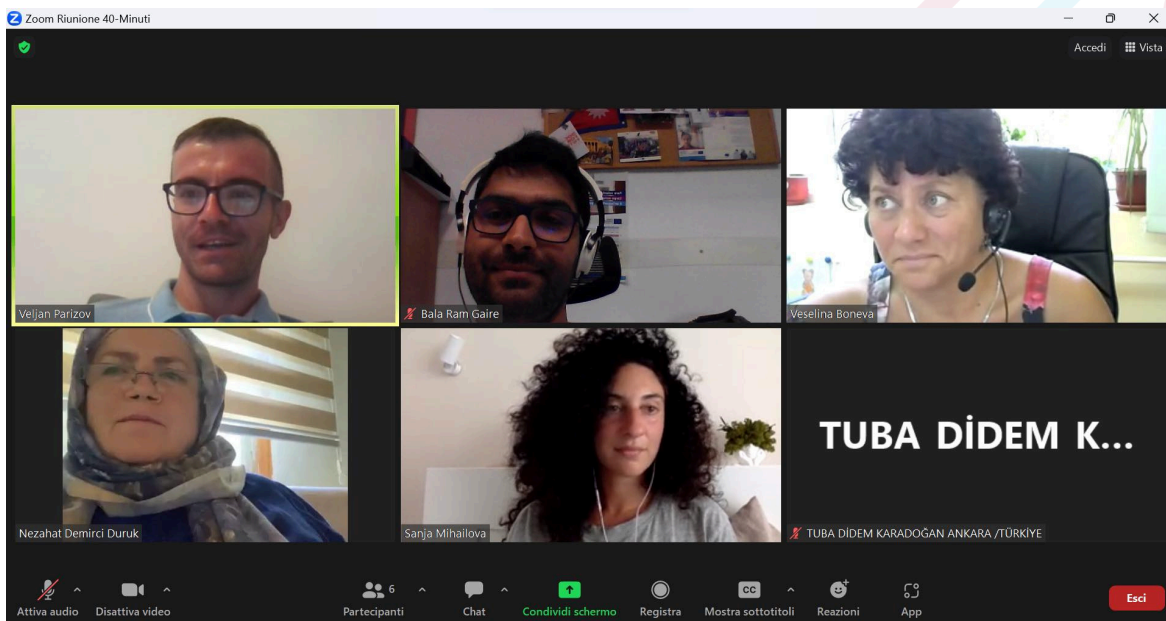
These plans served as a foundation for the development of interactive and accessible content, including quizzes, challenges, visual presentations, and short activities tailored to classroom and online learning environments.
