Objectives of the activity	
<p>Use appropriate vocabulary to describe</p> <p>Use appropriate words to describe an emotion</p> <p>Develop empathy (from grade 4)</p> <p>Tell to the teacher or write down what is the most important and what we could do</p>	
Details for the activity	
<p>Describe the activity.</p> <p>Material – Posters, questionnaire</p> <p>Duration – 45'</p> <p>Group number – Group of 4 - From 3 years old to 14 years old</p>	
Instructions and tips for teachers	
<p>Choose a picture for each group (depends on children age)</p> <p>One picture in different category</p> <p>https://www.goodplanet.info/</p> <p>https://www.un.org/sustainabledevelopment/sustainable-development-goals/</p> <p>Give them a sheet with different question to ask about this picture (youngest pupils will do it with their teacher)</p> <p>Observe and describe.pdf</p> <p>The teacher moves to each group to restart the activity or provide assistance.</p> <p>When the students have finished, show them each ODD logo (only show relevant logos for preschool or younger students) - (for oldest, you can provide a short summary of each logo added to each logo and they will have to choose)</p> <p>Ask each group to share their work and share their emotions</p> <p>Make your own poster for the classroom or school.
